

# The Good News Message

Jesus is alive. Jesus died and rose again.<sup>1</sup> Jesus is coming back.<sup>2</sup> Jesus is the only way to Heaven.<sup>3</sup> Jesus saves.<sup>4</sup> Jesus is able to do everything as mentioned in Luke 4.<sup>5</sup> Jesus is King, and He has a Kingdom.<sup>6</sup> The only way into this Kingdom is to be born again.<sup>7</sup>

Jesus died on the cross and took every sin upon His body. By His stripes, we are healed.<sup>8</sup> He suffered greatly for us all, so we could spend eternity with Him forever.<sup>9</sup> God loved the world so much that He sent His Son Jesus to die in our place.<sup>10</sup> God knew that we couldn't pay the price. The price was great, and we could never meet God's standards.<sup>11</sup> That's why Jesus came.

Jesus is the Word made flesh. Jesus became a human being.<sup>12</sup> Jesus walked this earth, and experienced every form of pain and rejection upon Himself.<sup>13</sup> He was rejected and despised. No one wanted to even look upon Him,<sup>14</sup> yet He did a great thing for us: He reconciled us back to the Father. Because of what Jesus did, we no longer have to be separated from God. Jesus died so we could once again have fellowship with the Father.<sup>15</sup> Jesus died so that we could have life.<sup>16</sup> Through Jesus, we have eternal life.<sup>17</sup> Through Jesus, we have forgiveness of sin.<sup>18</sup> Those who believe in Jesus will never really die, because Jesus is the One who gives life.<sup>19</sup> Jesus gives life to all who believe in Him.<sup>20</sup> And that eternal life begins the moment you receive Him into your heart.<sup>21</sup>

You don't have to do good works or deeds to get into Heaven.<sup>22</sup> All you have to do is believe in Jesus. Call upon His name. Ask Him to save you. Ask Him to deliver you. He is here. His Spirit is here to help you. Call upon the name of the Lord. Call upon Jesus, and you will be saved. For if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.<sup>23</sup> You will have eternal life. You will become a child of God, a citizen in God's Kingdom.<sup>24</sup> God's Kingdom is eternal.<sup>25</sup> God's

Kingdom is here now and is available to all who receive Jesus as Lord and Savior. Jesus is the only way to Heaven. There is no other name under Heaven by which we can be saved.<sup>26</sup>

One day, Jesus will return. He is coming back again.<sup>27</sup> And one day, He will rule and reign from this earth.<sup>28</sup> This message is not to scare you, dear one. This message is to let you know that time is short, and Christ's return is soon. Jesus the Christ will return again.<sup>29</sup> I say "again" because He came once as a baby, but when He comes the second time, He will come as conquering King.<sup>30</sup>

Now is the time to be ready, dear friend. Now is the time to listen. Now is the time. Don't harden your heart. Don't rebel against God.<sup>31</sup> Today is the day of salvation.<sup>32</sup> Take a moment right now and yield yourself to the Lord. Give Him your life. Surrender yourself to Him. He is here for you today. Allow Him to do the deep work of healing—healing your heart, and cleaning you from all sin. He is able. He is here. Let's pray together:

*Dear Jesus, I ask You to forgive me of all of my sins. I ask You to save me. I have turned my back on You, but now I come to You. Please cleanse me from all unrighteousness. Please heal me. Please heal me in every area of my life. Most importantly, please come to live within me. I want to know You. I want to have a relationship with You. I am Yours. I am Yours forever, my God, my King; and I choose to serve You for the rest of my days. Thank You, Lord, for dying for me and for saving me. I receive all that You have for me. I look forward to being with You forever. Amen.*

Dear brothers and sisters, now that you have prayed this prayer and received Jesus into your heart, by faith, you are now a new creation in Christ.<sup>33</sup> You are no longer the same. You are no longer that person you were a few minutes ago; Jesus is now in your heart.<sup>34</sup> What's wonderful is that His Spirit is with you. Yes, the Holy Spirit is with you. He will lead you and guide you, showing you the way through His truth that comes from God.<sup>35</sup>

Now, there are a few things that you must do: Regularly read the Word of God.<sup>36</sup> Get a Bible, and begin in the Book of John. Read and study the Word of God because that will transform your mind.<sup>37</sup> Another thing: Spend time praying to God every day. Learn to listen as well. This is fellowship. This is how you learn to hear His voice—by spending time with Him.<sup>38</sup> He wants to talk to you, so you must learn to listen too. Stay away from those things that dishonor Christ. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you find a place where you can learn more about Jesus.<sup>39</sup> I am so glad we had this time together. I am so glad you gave your life to the Lord. You will never be the same. Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.<sup>40</sup>
